Recipe Corner



Cajun Shrimp (or Chicken) and Andouille Alfredo Sauce Over Pasta

- 1 lb. shrimp
(or 3 cups chopped cooked chicken)
- 1/2 lb. andouille sausage, chopped
(or any good smoked sausage)
- 1 (12 oz.) pkg. fettuccine
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 4 celery ribs, chopped (about 1 cup)
- 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 1-1/2 Tbsp. cajun seasoning
- 3 Tbsp. all-purpose flour
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1-1/2 cups heavy cream
- 6 ozs. velveeta cheese, cubed
- 3/4 cup green onions, chopped
- 1/3 cup parmesan cheese
- 3 Tbsp. chopped fresh parsley

Peel and devein shrimp. Prepare fettuccine according to package directions, drain, and set aside.

Cook sausage in a large, heavy, Dutch oven over medium heat until browned, about 10 minutes; remove sausage and drain, reserving 1 Tbsp. drippings in Dutch oven. Set sausage aside.

Melt butter in drippings in Dutch oven over medium heat. Add shrimp, and cook 5 minutes or just until shrimp turn pink. Remove shrimp, and keep warm. (Omit this step is using chicken).

Add onion, bell pepper, celery and garlic, stirring constantly, over medium heat 10 minutes. Stir in cajun seasoning and flour. Cook over medium heat, 1 minute, stirring constantly. Gradually stir in chicken broth. Bring to a boil over medium heat, stirring occasionally.

Boil 1 minute. Reduce heat to medium-low, and stir in heavy cream; cook over medium-low heat 8 minutes or until mixture simmers. Add Velveeta cubes, sausage and shrimp (or chicken), stirring until cheese melts. Stir in chopped green onions, Parmesan cheese and parsley. Serve over hot cooked fettuccine.
