GPGC Skeet Tournament November 2011

Who is the Best Skeet Shooter at the Club?

The debate often wages over who is the best skeet shooter at the Grand Prairie Gun Club. The truth is that there are 30 plus shooters who shoot registered skeet and about a dozen more that are just good natural shooters but shoot mainly in leagues and club shoots. All of these shooters are more than capable of running straights and posting impressive scores. The real test is to be able to shoot under the pressure of competition.

The 2011 Grand Prairie Gun Club skeet championship was held Saturday November 12 and Sunday November 13 to settle this long ongoing debate. However, the debate was not actually settled as several shooters showed that they had what it takes to win. Jon McDonald won high overall and all 4 AA events but did not win any gun Championships. In C class, CW Dagnal shot the only 50 for the day to win 28 Gauge Gun Champ. Steve Bandy and Robert Nicholas both posted 49's to win the 12 and 20 gauge Gun Champs respectively and Jimmy Powell shot a 46 to win the 410 event.

On Sunday, Jon McDonald was the doubles champ shooting an impressive 98 out of 100 in some tough wind. Jason Foshea was right behind him with a 97. Several events were very competitive and ended up being settled in a shootoff. Jon McDonald defeated Robert Nicholas in the Shoot-off for the High Overall (HOA) both with 181's. Steve Hambrick and Jay Warren split shoot-

Ingredients

1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
1 Tbsp. grated Parmesan cheese
1 egg
1 Tbsp. BBC 1/2 tsp. salt1/8 tsp. pepper1-1/2 lbs ground beef6 slices bacon6 hamburger buns, split

- 1 Then Wareastern
- 1 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce

Directions

Preheat a grill for high heat.

In a large bowl, mix together the Cheddar cheese, Parmesan cheese, egg, bbq sauce, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper. Crumble in the ground beef, and mix together by hand. Form into 5-6 patties, and wrap a slice of bacon around each one. Secure bacon with toothpicks.

Place patties on the grill, and cook for 5 minutes per side, or until well done. Remove toothpicks before serving on hamburger buns.

Chili Relleno Casserole

Submitted by Maryann Jenkins From Virginia Rich's "The 27 Ingredient Chili Con Carne Murders"

Ingredients

3 sm. cans of split green chilis3/4 lbs. grated Monterey Jack Cheese3/4 lb. grated Longhorn Cheese3 whole eggs3 Tbsp. flour1-6 oz. can condensed milk

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix 3/4 pounds of grated Monterey Jack and 3/4 pound of grated longhorn cheese.

In a 9" by 12" casserole, layer the chilis and cheese, starting with a layer of chilis, ending with cheese on top.

In a separate bowl, mix and blend 3 whole eggs, 3 T. flour and 1-6 oz. can of condensed milk. Pour the mixture over the chili and cheese casserole. Bake for 30 minutes, top with a 6 oz. can of salsa and bake for 30 more minutes. It can be reheated.


